

Affinity Pin Quilted Banner Pattern

SUPPLIES

- 30" white cotton fabric for background
- Fat 1/8" blue cross
- Fat quarter dark/ medium red
- Scraps of yellow, blue, and green 1 1/2" squares
- Fusible web
- Freezer paper

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using your pattern, trace full pattern onto freezer paper. Use a dark marker. This pattern will be used for placement. Do not cut this pattern up. Other than cutting out the heart shape, trace pattern in two halves to fit freezer paper.
2. Cut your white background fabric to 30". Then, cut out the two half heart shapes. With the waxy side of the freezer paper facing down, position the heart in the center of the white square.
3. Using a fabric marker or pencil, lightly trace the shape of the heart onto the fabric. Remove freezer paper after tracing.
4. Set the background fabric aside.
5. With the fusible web (paper side up), place over the top of your pattern and trace the cross and triangle shapes.
NOTE: Make sure you also transfer number and letter for placement!
6. Using scissors, separate by color and place fusible web on wrong side your fabric and iron.
7. Remove paper backing and place pieces referring to your pattern. I find it easiest to lay all of this out where I plan to iron. I laid a towel on my cutting table and then placed the quilt top in position and used a cordless iron.
8. Position outer red triangle around the heart shape where your pencil marks are located.
9. Next, place the blue cross pieces, along with the colored squares.
10. Carefully iron in place, making sure the heart shape is where you want it.
11. Add fill-in red triangles and iron.
12. After everything is ironed on, use red thread and follow the edges of the heart with a sewing machine. I did a zig-zag stitch with red thread just inside each red triangle. Change thread to blue and zig-zag inside all blue pieces. Change thread to white and zigzag around yellow, blue, and green squares.

Your top is now finished! Sandwich the quilt top with batting and backing of your choice. I used white thread to quilt around the cross and triangles. I chose not to bind the quilt. Instead, I used a 2 1/2" strip of white fabric and brought it around as a blind hem.

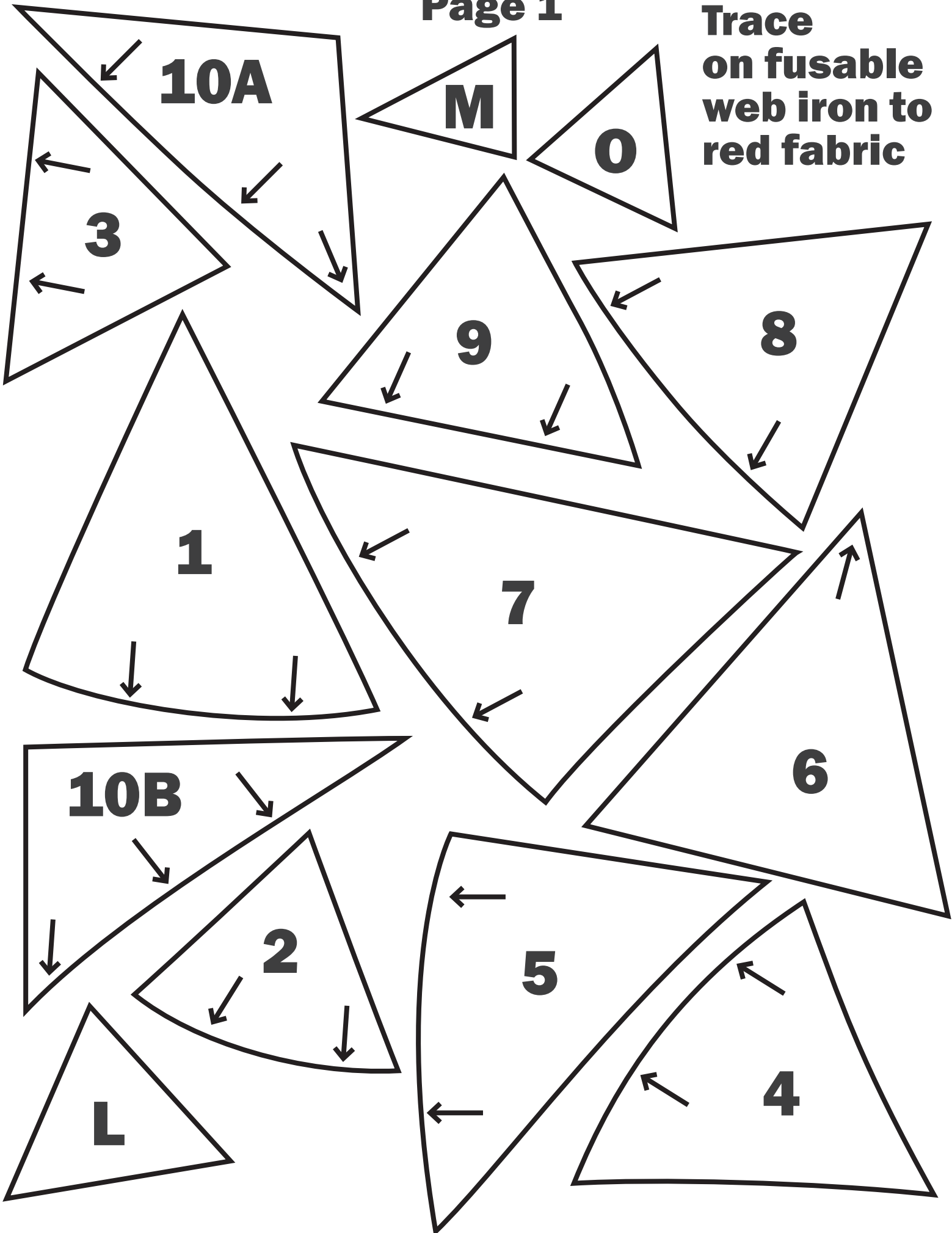

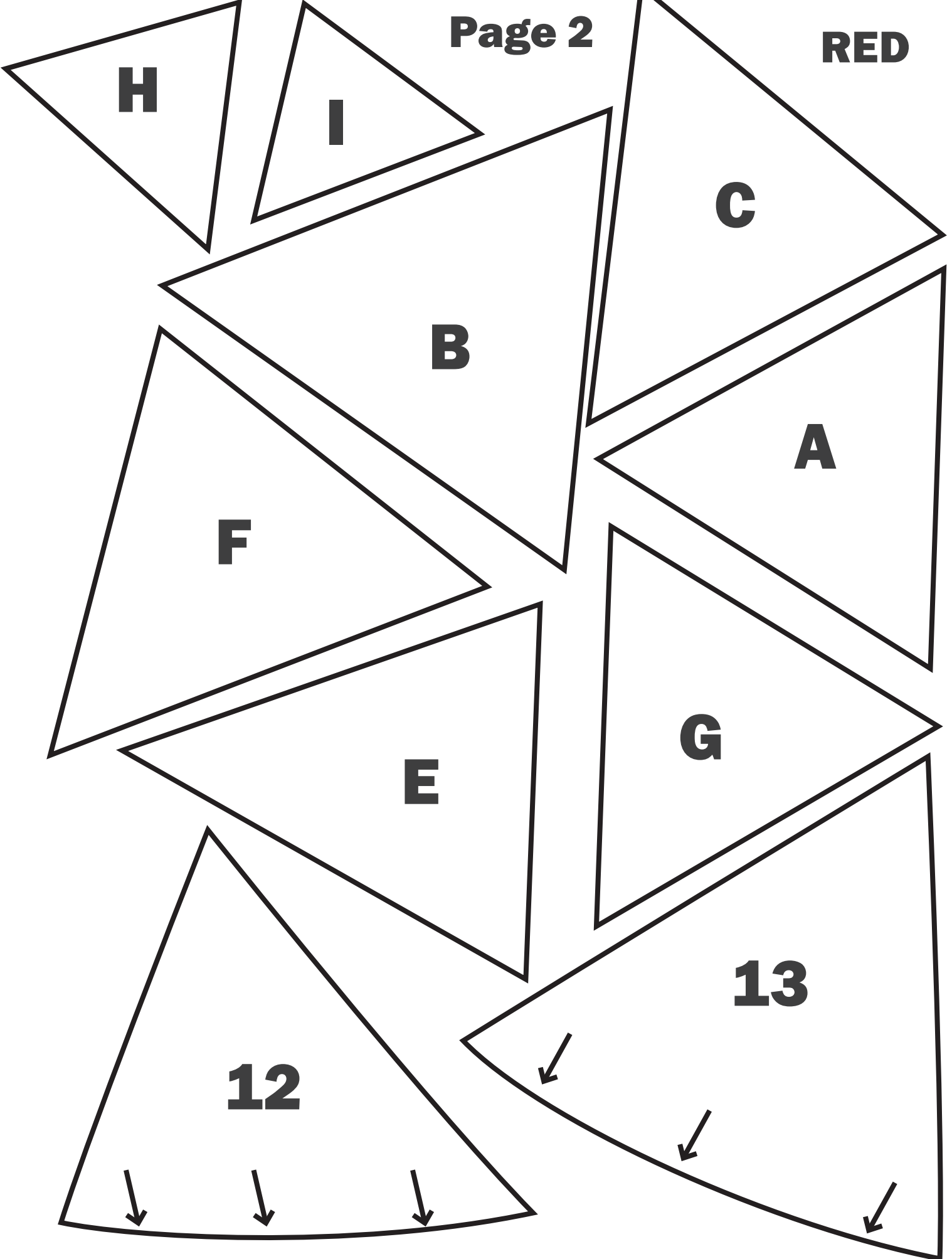
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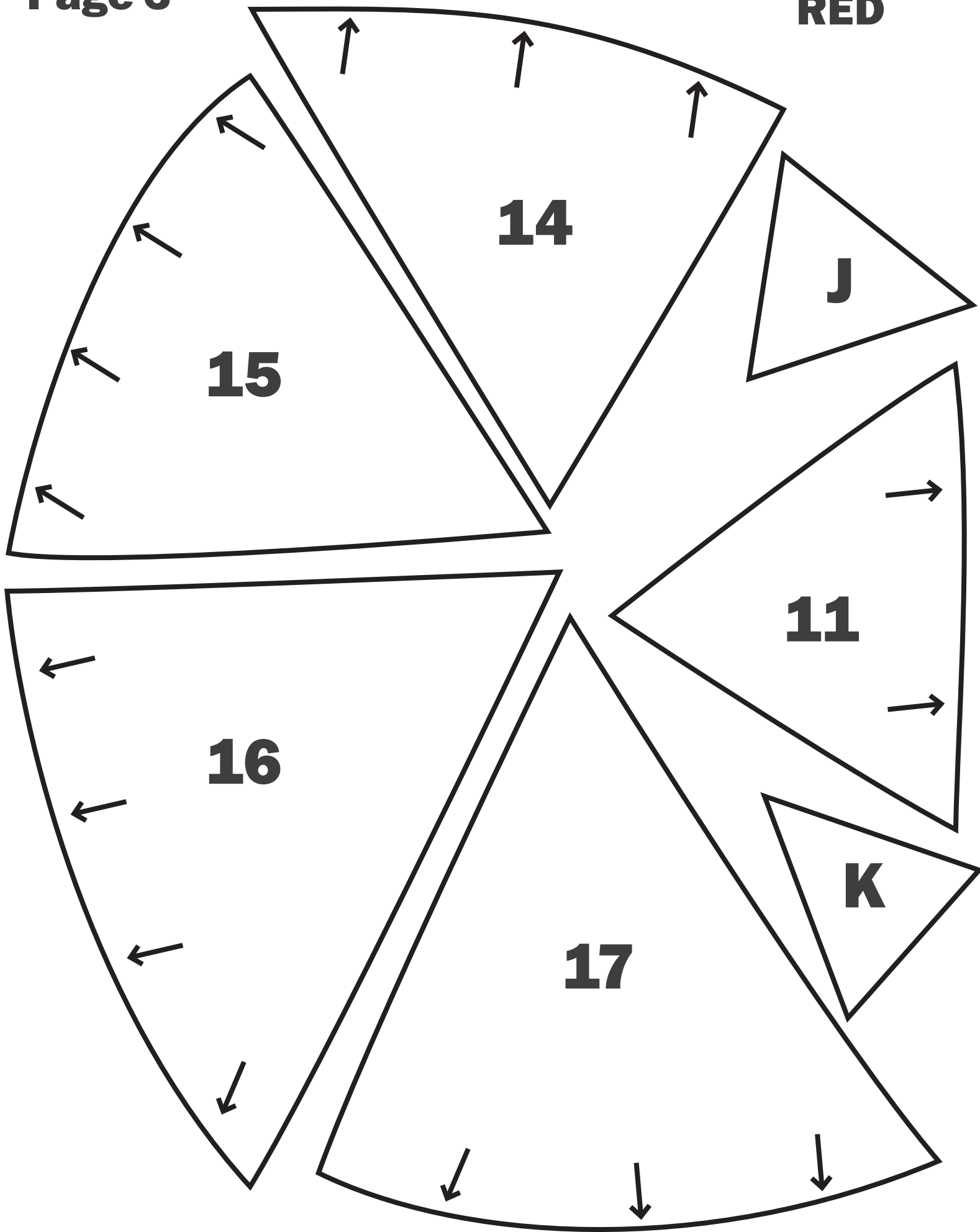
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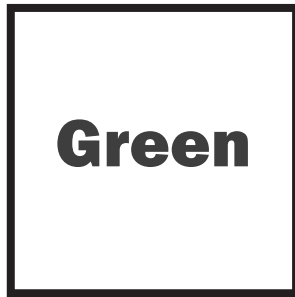
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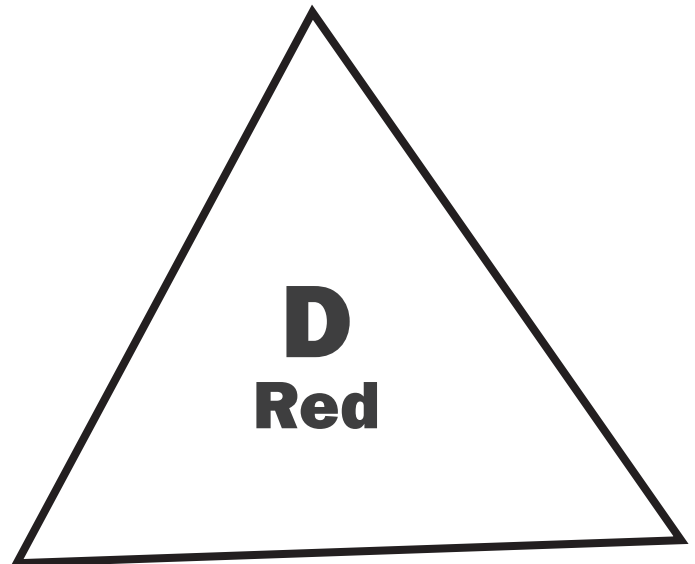
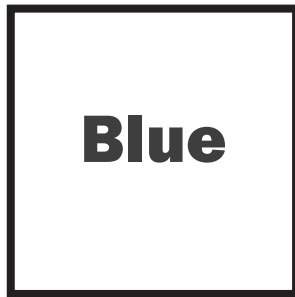
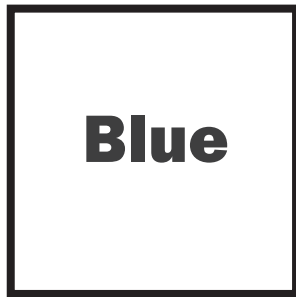




Cross Center Squares

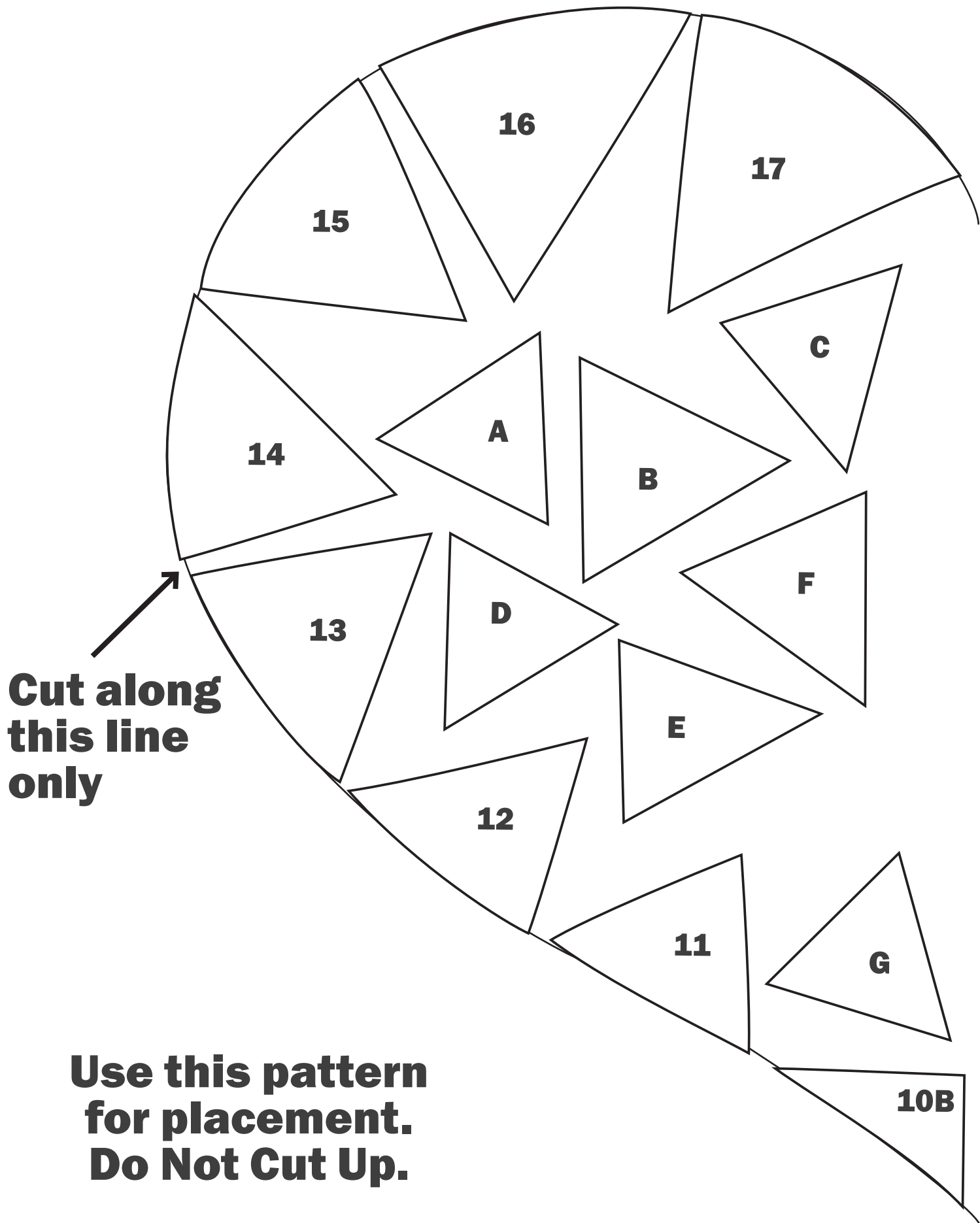

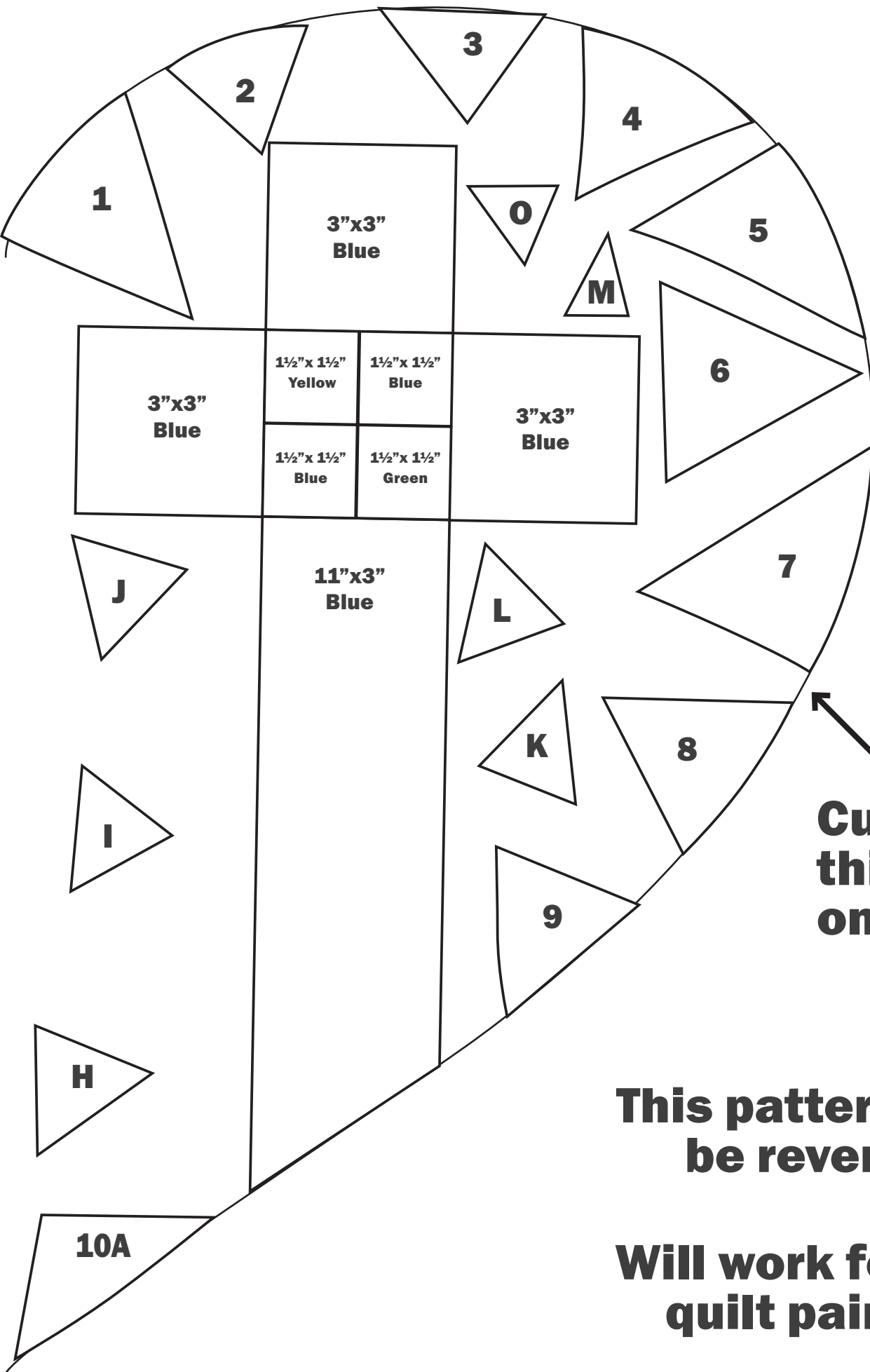
